How to make a Face Mask


You will need a cotton fabric, a pretty print is best Cotton flannel for the backing Rope elastic; beading cord elastic will work (You may also use 1/8" flat elastic) Cut the elastic 7" long and tie a knot at each end (DO NOT knot the ends of the flat)

You can make 2 sizes: Adult and Child

- 1. Put right sides of cotton fabric together Cut 9x6 (Adult) or 7.5x5 (Child).
- 2. Starting at the center of bottom edge sew to the first corner, stop. Sew the elastic with the know out into the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this.
- Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of that same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
- 4. Now sew across that top of the mask to the next corner. Again put an elastic with the know out.
- 5. Sew to next corner and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
- Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5" to 2" open. Stop, cut the thread. Turn inside out.
- 7. Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction.
- 8. Sew around the edge of the mask twice.

It is so easy to make this.

Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally.
